-Would your family be happy if you got this job? Why?

-What about your friends?

-Would it allow you to have other hobbies? Is that important for you?

-What do you think you could learn by working on this job?

-To end up, write a brief conclusion.

-And include some webpages to find out more about this job.


Of course, the earlier the better!
